DISCUSSION	 Enrollment is down to 405 students. Fall equalization made it look like we were losing 2 teachers. Since we needed to have an ELD teacher for 6th grade we did not end up losing anyone. 	



	 The Dean of Students starts on Sept 2nd. Century 21 has been funded with some changes. We will have 6 teachers but the same number of students of 100.
