- **Wednesday**-8:20am-1:40pm

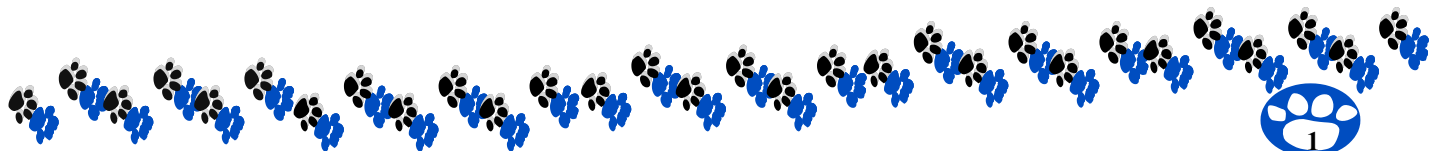
## **UNIFORMS ARE REQUIRED AT JOHN B. WRIGHT**

### MUY IMPORTANTE

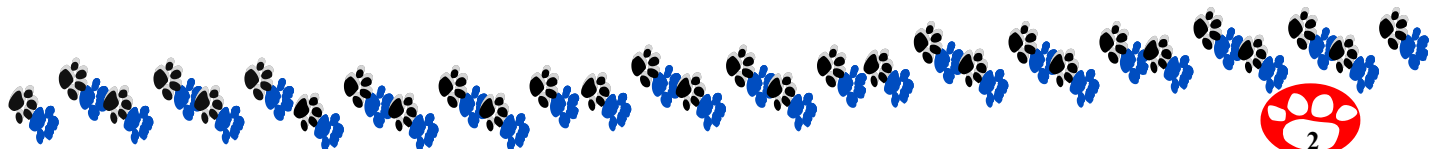
**Todos los estudiantes que estarán en persona en la escuela deben traer:**
